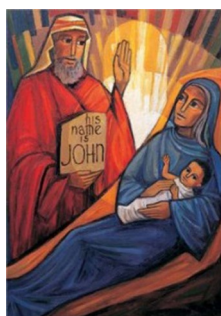

You belong to Jesus Christ and you belong to us!

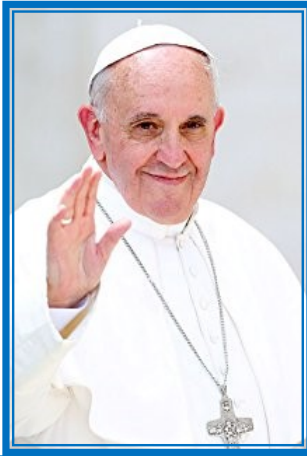
You are invited, accepted, and respected here at our parish.

Sacrament Class 2019 Update

Holy Trinity will begin offering the sacrament of confirmation to all children above the age of reason (7 years) in the spring of 2019. We look forward to an exciting year of sacramental preparation!

Your children must have a faith background on which to build an understanding of the sacraments. The Diocese of Honolulu requires at least one year religious formation prior to registration (and reception) of sacraments.

This will mean additional classes for elementary and middle school children, and of course more teachers needed.

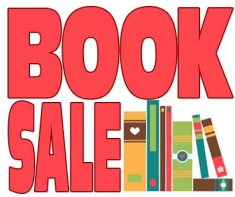
